"The idea of a relationship (or a family) to fall apart in the attempts of making/extending the family with a child is a very interesting concept, and it's the strongest plotline in the script. The choice of employment is very interesting. Jay and Cullen and Tessa are all at the frontline as ambulance drivers and an A&E doctor, but they never really come across as heroes (which is good), instead, they're just normal people. The bits with the elder couple are also nice, especially the last conversation with the elderly man. The relationship between this couple is a great reflection of the main story."
